Responsive Prayer of Confession

We seek the validation of family, friends, and even strangers instead of resting in our sacred worth and identity in You. And so, we travel the path of least resistance when we know that path does not align with Yours.

ALL: Forgive us, God, when we perform for one another instead of living with integrity in You.

One: Merciful God, we confess that we place too much value on money,

prestige, and influence. We live in a society that tells us we need more and more and more in order to live secure and satisfied lives, and we choose to live according to this lie to the detriment of ourselves and our neighbors.
